Key Action 2, School education Small scale partnership**

The implementation of the project will contribute to the achievement of the following results:

- establishing international contacts,
- strengthening the key competences of our students and teachers as well as students and teachers associated in partner organizations,
- raising the level of language competences of project participants (from all partner organisations),
- building a European network of contacts and establishing international cooperation,
- raising the level of knowledge of ancient history, tradition and culture of the countries associated in the partnership.

The selected priorities are:

- development of key competences (SCHOOL EDUCATION) - the implementation of the project will affect the level of key competences learners associated within partner organizations, will deepen the humanistic knowledge of students and teachers, will allow you to look at certain aspects from many points of view (history of Italy, Greece, Poland seen through the eyes of a given student nationality), people involved in the project will exchange experiences and knowledge, as well as compare known ones so far facts, etc. The project will also contribute to the development of social competences - networking, finding oneself in a new situation, environment, etc.
- promoting a comprehensive approach to teaching and learning foreign languages (SCHOOL EDUCATION) – implementation project will also affect the level of foreign language skills of people involved in the project, students and teachers cooperating in the partnership will use English as a working language, which will translate directly on its knowledge - as we know, the best effects are achieved by using the language in practice,

The result of this project will be teaching materials on history, tradition, culture of the countries associated in the partnership. These materials will be created at interest clubs, workshops and meetings of students and people who are participants of the project.

Each organization will select a group of participants who will directly participate in the activities design. These people will also be required to communicate the results worked out to other people in the company partner institutions. Co-financing the project will not allow the involvement of all people directly, which is why we will try to provide information and organize meetings already inside the organization without the need for large ones financial outlays.

Target groups show needs related to this project - establishing international contacts, strengthening language and social competences, strengthening competences related to the knowledge of history, tradition and culture of the countries associated in the partnership (Poland, Greece, Italy).

Students will be happy to take part in activities related to ancient history, which will be the main element project, want to get to know it from the perspective of students from abroad and compare it with their own information and knowledge.

Planned activities: workshops on history, tradition and culture of partner countries include:

- preparation for workshops through the organization of interest groups, extracurricular activities,
- conducting workshops for partner organizations.

Each organization will be responsible for conducting workshops for other partners. Initially, each organization will recruit students for activities or student interest clubs that show interest in the history,



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tradition and culture of other countries. During these activities/hobbies, students will explore country's history, traditions and culture. They will be preparing to present this information to their peers from abroad. The preparation for the workshops and the workshops themselves will be conducted under the supervision of teachers and trainers. A group of students/young people from each organization will participate in 2 mobilities abroad. It will be a group of representatives of people who participated in the activities/interest clubs.

In conclusion, each partner will be responsible for organizing workshops about the history of their country, culture and tradition.

The preparation and conduct of workshops for participants from abroad is a key element of this application. It directly affects the effects and results. This action will contribute to the achievement of the project's objectives, which are:

- establishing international contacts,
- strengthening the key competences of students and teachers involved in the activity,
- raising the level of language competence of project participants,
- building a European network of contacts and establishing international cooperation,
- raising the level of knowledge of ancient history, tradition and culture of the countries associated in the partnership.

Establishing international contacts will take place thanks to direct contacts of students and young people from different countries and teachers/trainers. They will also be in constant contact by electronic means of communication.

Such contacts will allow you to build a network of contacts for further cooperation, but also private contacts international students. Experience shows that students are eager to make new friends.

Participation in the activity will affect the level of key competences of participants and language competences.

Students and teachers will communicate in English, which will help overcome the language barrier.

Students will broaden their horizons and knowledge about ancient history, the history of a given country, and traditions and culture of a given country associated in the partnership.

The expected results of the action consisting in the preparation and conduct of workshops on history, traditions and culture of the partner countries are:

- development of didactic materials for learning history, gaining knowledge about the partner country - it is worth emphasizing that these materials will be prepared by students, under the supervision of the teacher, which ensures that they will be accessible to them other young people, and the information will be provided in an accessible and interesting way,
- raising the level of: knowledge of English among students and teachers, social competences, key competences, knowledge about the history, culture and customs of the partner countries.

We are sure that students and young people involved in the project will feel it for a long time after its completion positive results after participating in the activity. Their level of self-confidence, independence will increase, they will be more resistant to stress and will be able to find themselves in new situations and environments. They will become conscious citizens European Union, who will have knowledge about the opportunities offered by the Erasmus program. Moreover, we assume that participation in the project will arouse their curiosity about the world and it will be only the first step towards further travels and trips exploring the unknown, as the title of the project says. We want to activate youth through the implementation of this project and show them that the world is open to them.
